Out of an abundance of caution, we are taking immediate and precautionary steps to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Our top priority is to keep our employees, the people in the community safe and ensure our public health response is in line with the seriousness of this virus. Milwaukee County leaders have been working around the clock to implement staffing plans and continuity measures that seek to sustain public services during the spread of COVID-19.

We will be cancelling ALL existing rentals from now through April 17th. We will be in touch if this policy changes.

We will be putting a freeze on all new requested rentals that want to book for the next 8 weeks. We will continue to take reservations for folks who want to book something after May 15th. If your league is scheduled to start after April 17th, we are continuing to honor your specific start date at this time. Again, if this changes we will be in contact with you.

On a different note, I will be out on maternity leave starting tomorrow. Please continue to send correspondence to my e-mail as it will be monitored and replied to by Miguel. My plan is to come back part-time at the end of April.
